Bridge Expectations:

- Be a H.E.R.O (Here (Via Zoom), Everyday, Ready, and On-time).
- Be **respectful**, be **responsible**, be **kind**, and be **safe**.
- Preview your Seesaw/Google Classroom for the day/week.
- Watch all pre-recorded lessons provided by the teacher.
- Attend all Zoom class sessions.
- Fully participate in class lessons and discussions.
- Complete all assignments and assessments by the scheduled due date.
- Email your teacher if you have questions or need additional help so that the teacher can schedule a time to meet with you via Zoom.
- Most importantly...build relationships with your teacher/s and classmates. We superheros have to stick together, look-out for one another, and take care of eachother!

- Log on each day (with video-on), on time, and remain online the entire class session.
- > Dress in appropriate school attire.
- > Pick a quiet "classroom workspace" in your home, free of distractions or interruptions.
- Save your "big meals" for lunch time. Light snacking may be permitted with teacher permission.
- > Upon entering the Zoom session, mute your microphone and remain in mute status until given permission by the teacher.

Zoom Superhero Code of Conduct

- Screen names must reflect your actual first and last names (any changes require teacher permission).
- Keep the same Zoom background for the entire class session (any changes require teacher permission).
- Come to Bridge class prepared with necessary materials and completed assignments.
- > Actively participate and be engaged in the learning (use "whole-body" listening).
- If you have a question or would like to speak, follow the norms created by your teacher (ex. raise your hand on the screen or use the "raise hand icon", and the teacher will unmute you to ask or answer your question).
- > You may only use the group chat if your internet connection is poor or if your teacher instructs you to do so.
- Private chats are not allowed!



Please help your superhero create the best learning environment by:

- > Providing a quiet classroom space (free of background sounds, conversations, and noise)
- > Helping your child organize their workspace and materials (supplies should be nearby)
- > Setting-up the computer camera so that others in the household cannot be <u>seen</u> or <u>heard</u>
- Making sure your child's Zoom screen name (first and last) is reflected accurately (ATTENDANCE WILL BE TAKEN THROUGHOUT EACH CLASS SESSION).
- Communicating your questions/thoughts/concerns via email to the teacher and not during your child's Zoom instructional time
