Monart is an educational drawing method developed through grant funding from Pepperdine University in 1979. Monart teaches your child fundamental drawing skills that last a lifetime, while helping them develop their focus, fine motor skill, hand-eye coordination, problem solving and self-confidence in a fun and non-competitive environment. With the MONART Drawing Method, your child will show clear progress over time and learn techniques they can use outside the classroom!

SESSION 1: SAN DIEGO ZOO!

Examples: Elephants, tigers, hippos, parrots, flamingos, apes, pandas, etc.

An exciting adventure for all animal lovers. It will include an endless variety of animal subjects for our directed drawings. A variety of media including markers, graphite, color and watercolor pencils, etc. will allow students to enhance their drawings creatively. Each week a fact sheet will come home accompanying a completed drawing.
